2009-10 Dare to Dream Award Winners



The Foundation had such exemplary entries for its annual \$5,000 "Dare to Dream" award contest this year, that not one, but two winners were selected! The purpose of the grant is to foster and promote creativity and innovation within the district, and this year's winners are **Eric Paulsen of Winona Middle School** and **Mary Cappel of Jefferson Elementary**.

Eric Paulsen's \$4,300 award will fund an expansion of the Lego Mindstorm NXT Robotics platform at WMS which will enable entire classes to use robots to explore multiple topics within the curriculum. Examples include using robots for active measurement as well as to explore geometry,

programming and the laws of motion/physics. In addition to use in the classroom, the robotics and computer equipment purchased with this grant will also be used for after-school activities and a Student Robotics Club.

Mary Cappel's \$3,000 award will benefit all Jefferson Elementary students with a program that incorporates physical activity into classrooms and academics to help students become more successful learners. Mary has based her program on several large scale research studies which show how active bodies create active brains with improved thinking skills. The grant will provide teacher training and "Energizer" flip booklets that offer each classroom an easy guide for age appropriate activities that reinforce academic learning. Also, "Geomotion-Learnercise" materials will be purchased that students move on to spell, do math problems and learn physical skills.




Check Our Vision Breakfast
